The Director of Education is the professional leader of the Stein Valley Nlaka'pamux School Society. S/he is responsible for overseeing the Stein Valley Nlaka'pamux School, adult education programming, transportation, operations and maintenance of all capital assets (school, maintenance buildings, teacher housing, school buses and gas station) financial management and control. This position is an employee of the Board of Directors, the Director of Education manages and implements the strategic plan, policies and works in collaboration with Human Resources manager under the direction and guidance of the Stein Valley Nlaka'pamux Board.

This position is a leadership role that provides guidance and direction to a team of diverse educators and to weave together a learning environment of excellence. The Director will work closely and in collaboration with the School Principal and the SVNS Board.
